You would think that the Collect for Christmas Day would say a bit more than what it does, especially for a day like Christmas. But it doesn't. It's short and gets right to the point. It's as bare and plain as the manger in Bethlehem.

It serves as an antidote for contemporary living. Christmas has become complicated and stressful in American life. It has become as complex as we are. The birth of Jesus was not complex and happened almost without notice. If it wasn't for the shepherds and the Magi, no one would have known. The day and the night passed without much fuss. This simplicity is reflected in the Collect for Christmas Day.

Woven within that simplicity is truth bearing such profundity—a young woman giving birth to divinity, heaven coming to earth, glory clothed in the mundane, sacred rescue from sin's bondage—that it transforms life as we know it. It calls and beckons us to stop in our tracks and participate in its mystery now revealed in the flesh, the Great Reversal now manifested in humble infancy:

Divinity giving birth to a new humanity, earth being swept up to heaven, mortality being clothed with righteousness and immortality, human sin being assumed into the infinite wellspring of divine grace. Forgiveness. Life. Salvation. All encapsulated and communicated in that bare and plain Collect, but more concretely lying in a manger in Bethlehem.
