We have our own Church Planters in India!!

More information about them will be forthcoming, but they are two young ladies who are eager to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ in Tamil Nadu, India. The funds we raised from our Multiplication Program will be used for their training at Mission India in Hyderabad. We will be putting their names in the prayers of the church every Sunday, and we will be listing them as OUR Church Planters.

As we raised close to \$5,000 to pay for their training, there will be upwards of 12 churches planted in India by these women. And then these churches will most likely plant more churches as they send some of their own people to Mission India for church planter training.

We will be receiving field reports from our Church Planters occasionally. Watch for a display that will be made, focusing on the Church Planters and the progress they will be making.

God is using us and our efforts to plant churches on the other side of the world. Let that sink in for a moment, and then praise God for His graciousness. And on my own part, I want to thank all of you for taking the time to put projects together to raise funds for Mission India. God is truly blessing us and equipping us to be a blessing to others!


