Dear Friends of Trinity,

Beginning June 1 and all the way through Christmas Eve, you will notice that the Christ Candle will not be lit during worship (with rare exceptions). Here's why:

Thursday, May 29, is Ascension Day, commemorating the time when Jesus took his rightful place of authority over all of creation at the right hand of God. It marked the end of his visible ministry on Earth and the beginning of his invisible ministry in heaven as the one interceding to his Father on our behalf. The Christ Candle is unlit as a symbol of Jesus' invisible ministry.

But that doesn't mean that Jesus has no ministry on Earth at all. That's when Pentecost comes in, which we will commemorate on Sunday, June 8! The Holy Spirit, proceeding from the Father and the Son, continues Jesus' ministry *through the church*. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, we make the invisible Christ visible as we are his body.

Jesus also ministers to his body (that's us) by the Holy Spirit through the reading and proclamation of the Word of God and the giving of the Sacraments. These make the invisible Christ visible *for us*. Then we, in turn, make the invisible Christ visible to others because of what we have received.

Come to worship. Receive the tangible grace of God. Be renewed in faith. Love and serve others through your station in life, whatever that is!
