Speaking of things financial:

<u>2012 Financial Report:</u> The congregation adopted a 2012 General Fund Budget of \$193,269 at its Annual Meeting on January 29. The Budget is 2.2% higher than contributions made to the General Fund in 2011. The Council deemed the increase warranted to cover expected higher operating costs. A modest salary increase of 2% was granted to Pastor, the Secretary, Organist and Choir Director. Primary support of the General Fund by the congregation is very important to meeting Trinity's ongoing needs.

Our congregation was truly blessed with financial support during 2011. Even though General Fund receipts were lower than in 2010, special donations and lower expenses allowed for the payment of all bills and modest increases in debt repayment and endowment funds. We met our final commitment to the Manhattan Mission and exceeded our budgeted remittances for Synod Missions, LCCF and Debt repayment. The balance on the original \$100,000 mortgage, used to finance the new restrooms, was \$29,196.84 at year-end. We want to thank everyone for their support of Trinity Lutheran Church and its missions.
