UPDATE FROM OUR COUNCIL PRESIDENT, Bob Blecke

Trinity's annual congregational meeting was held on 2/14/21 at 1130 in the gym. Despite weather and pandemic, we had 9 council members and 14 congregational members attend. As you might guess, many of the retrospective reports focused on limitations imposed by, and challenges overcome due to COVID19 mitigation. The underlying good news is that we remain a viable and active congregation who, with very few exceptions, was able to maintain a full range of services and activities despite the limitations of the year, and some of the lessons learned in extending our reach into social networks will continue and be improved in the future. The congregation passed a proposed budget for 2021 that includes a modest increase in salaries and anticipated benefits cost increases, due to the ongoing generosity and support of the Trinity family. Given the completion of the Kitchen project and the work in Fellowship Hall, we come to the end of several years of capital improvement projects that have left us in good physical condition, and prepared to re-engage in the full range of in-person activities as the state's numbers improve. My thanks to the council for their faithful stewardship in 2020, the congregation for their faithfulness, to outgoing Council President Jeff McDonald for his years of service, and a welcome to new addition Mike Gardner for taking on the mantle of Outreach. I wish all of the Trinity family the best in 2021, and hope to see you soon.
