And we become a whole army of warriors when we gather for worship, finding strength in numbers, and building up one another with the comfort given in the good news of Jesus Christ. Having just paid off our mortgage in January, we would love to remain debt-free at the conclusion of these two projects and we are hoping our congregation can come together to make that possible.
