I have discovered for myself a newly-found appreciation for hymns which are found under the heading of *The Church Militant*. If you're curious you can find these hymns in the Lutheran Service Book (LSB) by hymn numbers 655 through 669. These hymns remind us that our real enemies are not people, but rather our struggle is "*against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.*"—*Ephesians 6:12*. All of these are called "*the schemes of the devil.*" It is these that seek your heart and mind to empty them of Christ.

The hymns remind us of the Scriptural truth that in Jesus Christ we already have the victory over these plots and schemes and it is our privilege to hold on to that victory as we put on the whole armor of God for the great defensive against the evil day and stand firm. And for the great offensive, we have the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God.

Even in these times of violence, uncertainty, and confusion we still have all of the counsel of God for our unlimited use. And we become a whole army of warriors when we gather for worship, finding strength in numbers, and building up one another with the comfort given in the good news of Jesus Christ. And in the end all of those in *The Church Militant* will receive their crown of life in *The Church Triumphant*!

Ushers - be sure to check the schedule for the dates you are scheduled to usher.



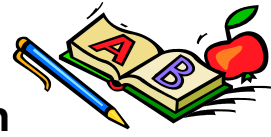

## 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

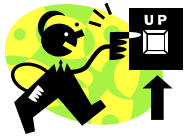

***We are hoping to tackle two significant improvements as part of our 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary.*** Both are long-needed improvements to our church, but both will involve a fairly large investment by our congregation. ***We hope to have a lift installed and we hope to raise enough funds to purchase a new organ for the church.*** We have received a number of memorial funds over the years for these projects, but we are projecting the total cost to be greater than what we have available. *We prayerfully ask that all members consider supporting one or both of these projects so that we can complete them both without incurring any additional debt.* Members are encouraged to use their “Designated Offering” or “Debt-Reduction Fund” envelopes to help us raise funds for these projects, or you can write a check to Trinity Lutheran Church and state “Lift” or “Organ” in the subject line to designate a donation to this effort. Having just paid off our mortgage in January, we would love to remain debt-free at the conclusion of these two projects and we are hoping our congregation can come together to make that possible.

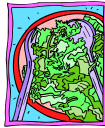
**Chancel:** All ladies are welcome to join us.
