I don't know if you've ever noticed, but our baptismal font is shaped like an octagon. This is on purpose. In fact, most of the furnishings in the sanctuary are built the way they are on purpose. But back to the baptismal font.

The points of the octagon represent all of the main directions of the compass: N, NE, E, SE, S, SW, W, and NW. This is to remind us that the people redeemed in baptism's water come from all directions, all cultures, all races, and all nations.

The eight sides of the octagonal baptismal font represents the 7 days of the week (creation) plus the 8th day, which corresponds to the 1st day, which means that baptismal candidates are new creations in Christ Jesus and made a member of the body of Christ along with us.

We have all entered the octagon, where our sinful nature was drowned and put to death, and our body and spirit were raised with Christ. We all came from many and various places to the font where we were engaged in the fight of our lives. We lost. But God gave us the spirit of Christ who raised him from death and we were given victory!

The struggle is real! We daily fight the battle as Baptism indicates that through daily contrition and repentance the Old Adam is drowned and dies with all sins and evil desires, and a new creature emerges and rises to live before God in righteousness and purity forever.

Praise the Lord for His wonderful gift of Baptism!
